15) Curious what a provisional ballot is? It looks just like a regular ballot, however, they are not counted until election officials are able to verify the voter was qualified to vote in the election, did not vote more than once, and was able to (if necessary) provide additional proof of residency.

16) Voting in person and not registered to vote? Election officials require you to bring your current, unexpired NV driver's license, a state ID card or a current DMV temporary document. If the addresses on a DMV item don't match your actual address, you'll need to bring in additional proof of residency such as a utility bill, bank or credit union statement, an income tax return or property tax statement, or any other document issued by a government agency.
